DOUBLE FIGURE SLOWDOWN, IN JUNE, FOR THE ITALIAN AUTOMOTIVE PRODUCTION INDUSTRY (-11.8%), WHICH CLOSE THE FIRST SEMESTER WITH A -9.6%

Car production keeps a decreasing trend, with a slowdown of 23% during the month, and it closes the semester with a -19%, while the total of cars produced from January to June is about the 14% less than the first semester of 2018

Turin, August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2019 - According to ANFIA data, in June 2019 the **national** vehicles production in Italy decreases of 23% respect to June 2018.

In the first semester of the current year, car production, the 51% of it is addressed to the international markets (it was the 55% in the first semester of 2018), shows a slowdown of 19%.

In the same period, the overall of the vehicles produced in Italy<sup>1</sup>, the 63% of it addressed to the export, is in slowdown of 14%.

In July 2019, the Italian car market shows a decrease of the sales of 0.1%. The first seven months of 2019 close with a negative sign: -3%. In July, registration of FCA Group registered a market share of 22%, with volumes in slowdown of 19%. In the other sectors show a positive sign, from January to June 2019, only light commercial vehicles (+5.5%, with a growth of 3% in June) and light trailers (+2%, with an increase of 0.4% during the month), while are in slowdown trucks (-0.2%, in spite of the +38% of June), buses (-8%, with a slowdown of 3% in June) and heavy trailers and semitrailers (-7%, while the decrease during the month is of 3%).

In May 2019 (last data available), the value of the export of cars from Italy is about 1.9 billions of Euro, the 4.5% of the total exported, which decreases of 7.4%. The import instead values 3.2 billions of Euro (+1.2% respect to May 2018), which is the 8.3% of the total imported in Italy. The United States are still, in terms of value, the first country as destination for the export of cars from Italy with a share of 16%, followed by France and Germany, respectively with a share of 15% and of 14%.

In Italy, the index of the industrial production <sup>2</sup> decreases of 1.2% in June 2019.

"The Italian Production of the Automotive Industry <sup>3</sup> register during June a trend of decrease of 11.8%, which follows the decreases already registered in the first five months of 2019 and in the last three months of 2018 - says Gianmarco Giorda,

Director of ANFIA. The closing of the first semester of 2019 is negative, with a trend of variation of -9.6%.

Also the Italian production of parts and accessories for vehicles and their engines <sup>4</sup> registers once again a slowdown during June (-6.1%) and in the cumulate too (-6.5%)".

During May, according to the last data available, the orders of this specific sector are decreasing of 4.1%, because of the slowdown of the national orders (-10.4%) and because of the growth of the international orders (+2.4%). In the first five months of the year, orders register a slowdown of 7.4% (-13.9% and -1.2% respectively national and international). Also the income of components shows a slowdown of 4.2% during the month, because of the national part which decreases of 11.8%, and of the international one which grows of 4,2%. During the period from January to May 2019 the index of the income decreases of 5.7%, with a national part in slowdown of 13.4% (+2.2% the international income).

Orders<sup>5</sup> in the automotive sector shows a decrease of 13.7% in May (results of a national part -16.3 % and of an international part in slowdown of 9.9%). In the first five months of 2019, orders decrease of 11.1% (-13.2% in the national market and -8.5% in the international market). The orders of the industry (with the only exception of the Manufacture sector) present, instead, a slowdown of 2,5% during May (-0.8% the national part and -5% the international one) and of 2.1% in the first five months of 2019 (-1.2% the national part and -3.4% the international one).

The income<sup>6</sup> in the automotive sector, in the end, shows a decrease of 3.6% in May (-5.6% the national income and -0.6% the international one). In the first five months of 2019 the income decreases of 9.6% (-13.3% the national income and -4.4% the international one). For the industry the income (with the only exception of the Manufacture sector), grows of 0.2% in the month (+1% on the national market and -1.3% on the international ones) and of 0.4% from January to May 2019 (+0.5% on the national market and +0.4% on the international ones).
