A DIFFICULT START FOR CARS IN ITALY IN 2020: -5.9% IN JANUARY

Registrations of hybrid cars, included recharging ad electric ones (PEV), double their volumes respect to January 2019 reaching the highest share registered ever (11.3%)

Turin, February 3rd 2020 - According to the data published today by the Ministry of Infrastructure and Transport, in January the Italian car market totalized 155,528 registrations, with a slowdown of 5.9% respect to the same month of 2019.

"After the restart of sales of last September, with also a December in double figures growth (+12.5%), car market opens the new year with a negative sign (-5.9%), also because a working day less (21 working days in January 2020 instead of 22 of January 2019) - says Paolo Scudieri, President of ANFIA.

Hybrid (chargeable cars included) and electric cars (PEV) registrations, during January, double their volumes respect to January 2019 and they reach the highest share ever registered (11.3%). Mild and full hybrid cars grow of 74% with a market share of 9.2%. Chargeable cars in January 2020 are almost 5 times more than the best sell in January 2019, thanks to the strong positive variations both of the electrics (BEV: +546% and 1.2% of share), and of the hybrids plug-in (PHEV: +269% and 0.8% of share), and they represent the 2.1% of registrations.

Data, since the beginning of the year, show as excepted that 2020 it will be the key year for the selling BEV and PHEV cars, thanks to the ecobonus and to the stringent measures for the CO₂ reduction that cars manufacturers have to deal with. For this reason since the end of last year, institutions have been pushed for the adoption of actions, direct and indirect, in support of the electric mobility. Nowadays situation is getting worse, since the advanced resources of the 2019 bonus have not been recovered, the ceiling of 70 millions of Euro in 2020 will be necessary also for the purchase of bike and motorcycles (even if only for 8 millions), nothing more has been done to help private owners in the placement of wallbox and either for the removing of the financial barriers. Tomorrow there will be the group of work called "Demand" of the Automotive table established by MISE and at the moment amendments for the Milleproroghe Decree Law are under review: ANFIA hopes that no more time will be lost in the realization of the always more necessary (without any postponements), of the conditions for the development of the new mobility.

In the end, the slow start of the car market arrives in the context where the Automotive Industry Production is in slowdown, even if few positive signs have been seen last December, and it shows other criticalities to deal with like the effects for this sector, of the Brexit, last February 1st".

Analyzing registrations by fueling¹, during January, diesel cars are still in decrease (24%), with a share of 33.2%, which means 8 % points less respect to January 2019. To find a lower monthly share we have to back to February 2001, when it was 32.4%. In slowdown also petrol cars, which decline of 3% during the month and they represent the 47% of the market of January. Alternative powered cars reach the share of 20.1% during the month (the higher since April 2010), in increase of 38%.

LPG cars decrease of 21% and they reach the 6.2% of share.

In the end, methane cars keep a good trend, in increasement of 136%, with an overall share on the market of 2.6%.

Referring to the **market by segments**, during January 2020 super economy cars registrations are decreasing of 14.5% (the best sold models are Fiat Panda and Fiat 500) while of 9% economy ones, the best sold model is Lancia Ypsilon. Medium cars (the best sold car in November is Fiat Tipo) decrease of 2%, with the lower-medium in slowdown of 3% and the higher-medium in increase of 4%. In slowdown of 3% all sizes SUVs (17% of registrations is represented by FCA Group), which represent the 40% of the market, with small SUVs (the best sold are Fiat 500X and Jeep Renegade) which show no variation and medium SUV in slowdown, respectively, of 5% and of 6.5%, while big SUV slightly increase (+0.9%). Variation is positive also for monovolumes registrations, which in January increase of 9%. In the end, higher-cars are in strongly decrease (-32.5%), luxury cars are also in slowdown (-6%), while sportive ones increase of 17%.

According to ISTAT survey, in January the consumer confidence climate index (basis 2010=100) increase from 110.8 to 111.8. **index of the company confidence climate (lesi)**, instead, register a slowdown, passing from 100.7 to 99.2.

Referring to the consumer confidence climate, in the field of the purchase of the long-lasting goods, and among them there is the car, the balance regarding the current opportunity is increasing during December 2019 (from -51.6 to -47.9).

According to the last ISTAT data available, during December, the **national index of consumer prices** grows of 0.2% respect the previous month and of 0.5% per year (in growth from 0.2% of the previous month), confirming the preliminary estimate. In average, in 2019, consumer prices grow of 0.6%, cutting the 2018 average (+1.2%). The slightly increasing of the inflation during December is given by the trend reversal of the prices of the energetic goods not regulated (which pass from -3% to +1.6%).

In this last sector, looking at the trend of fuels prices, arise that Petrol prices go from -3.2% of November to +3,1% (+0.5% more respect the previous month) and Diesel ones from -4.7% to +0.3% (+0.4% per month), while it slowdown the decrease of other fuels from -10% to -7.6% (+1.1% the situation).

National brands, in the overall totalize during the month 40,432 registrations (+0.3%) with a market share of 26%. FCA brands (excluding Ferrari and Maserati) totalize in the overall 39,878 registrations during the month (+0.2%), with a market share of 25.6%. A positive trend for Fiat brand (+5.6%). Positive also for Ferrari (+50%), DR (+28.8%) and Lamborghini (+39.1%).

In the **top ten of January** there are five models, at the top always Fiat Panda (14,417 units), followed by, at the second place by Lancia Ypsilon (6,251) and at the fourth Fiat 500X (3,575), which gains four places. At the eighth there is Jeep Renegade (3,260), followed at the tenth by Fiat 500 (2,863).

The **second-hand** market totalize 338,754 ownerships transfers, including the mini-transfer operations to car dealers during January 2019, registering a slowdown of 10.3% respect to the same month of 2019.

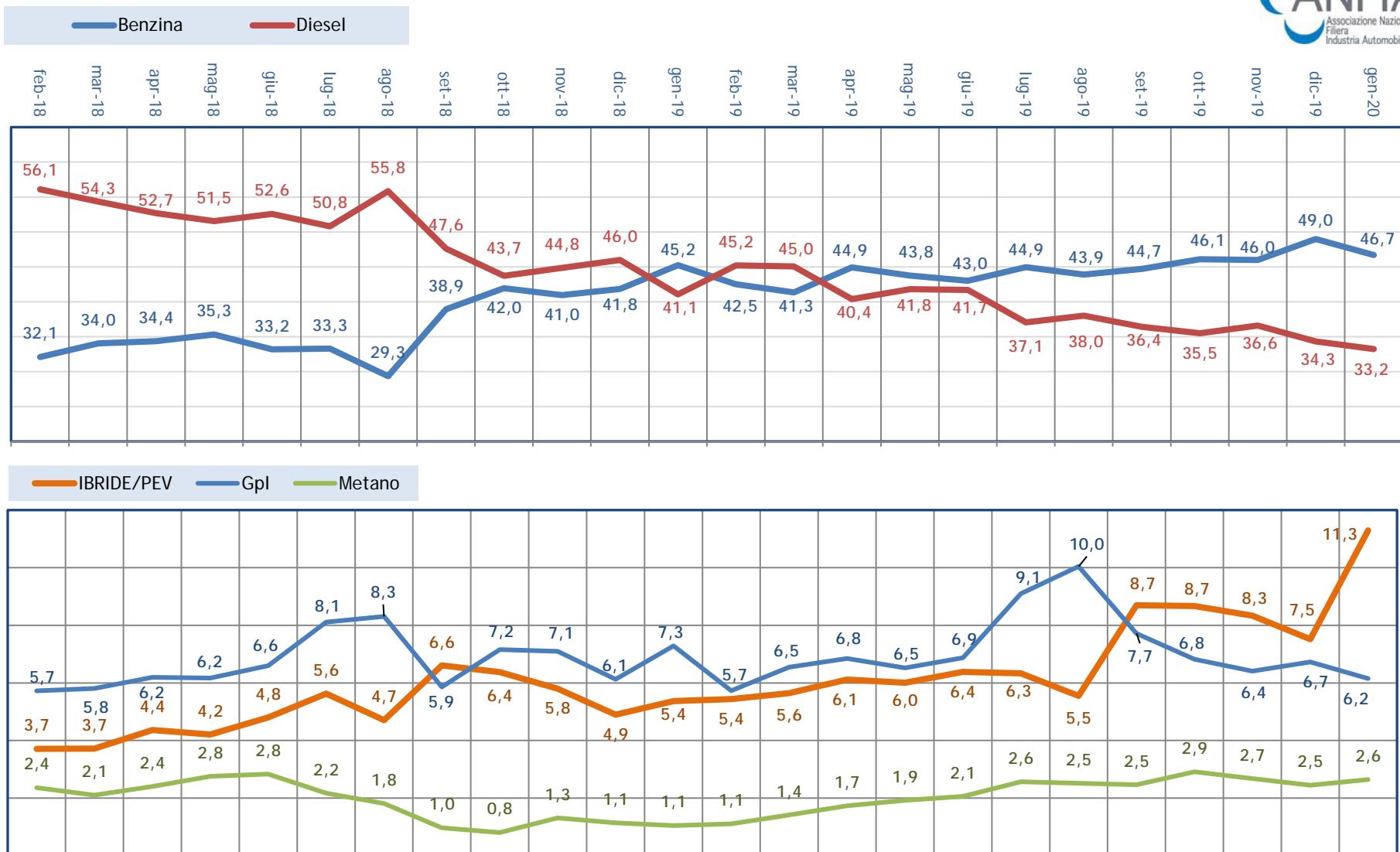
